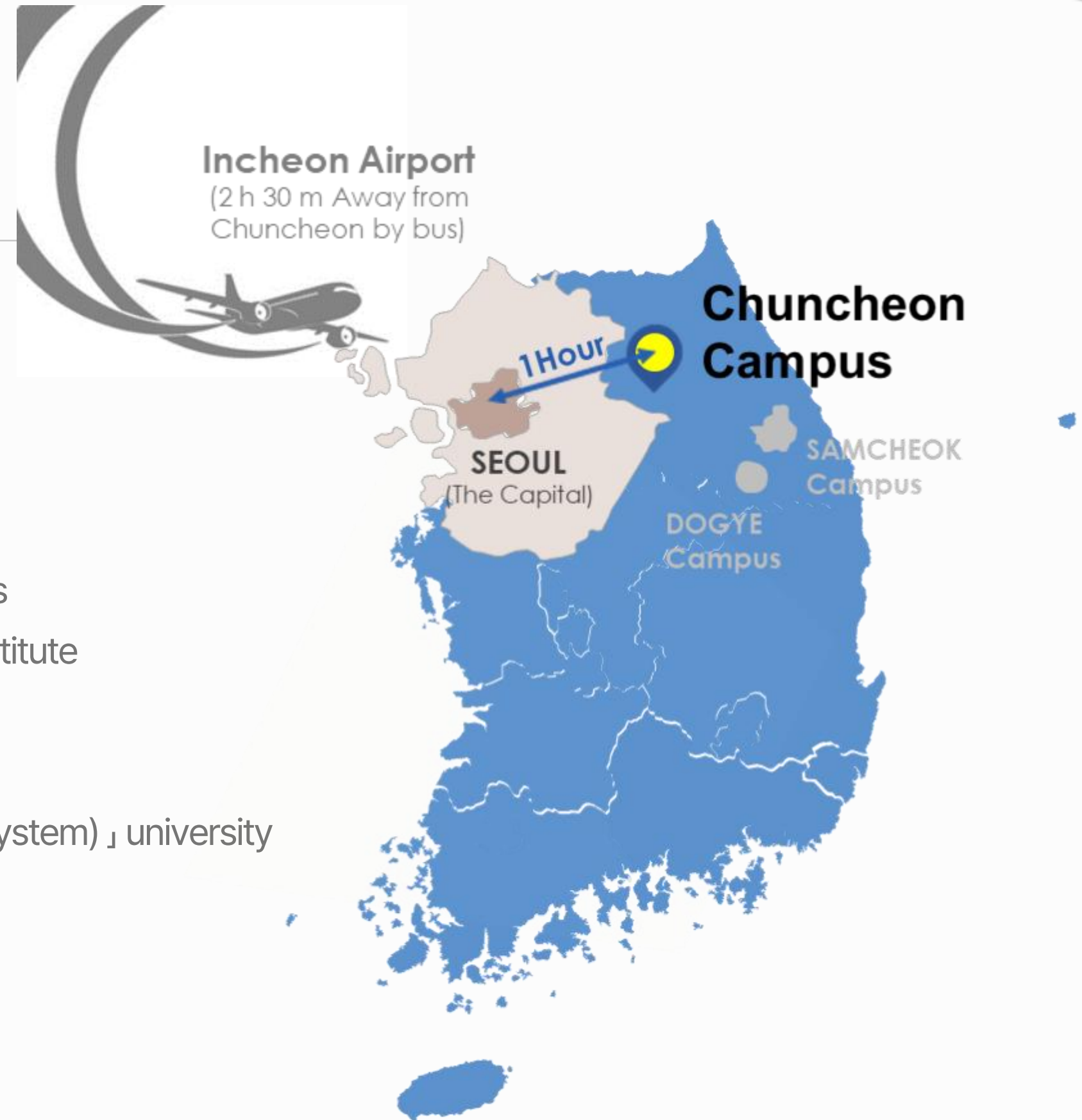

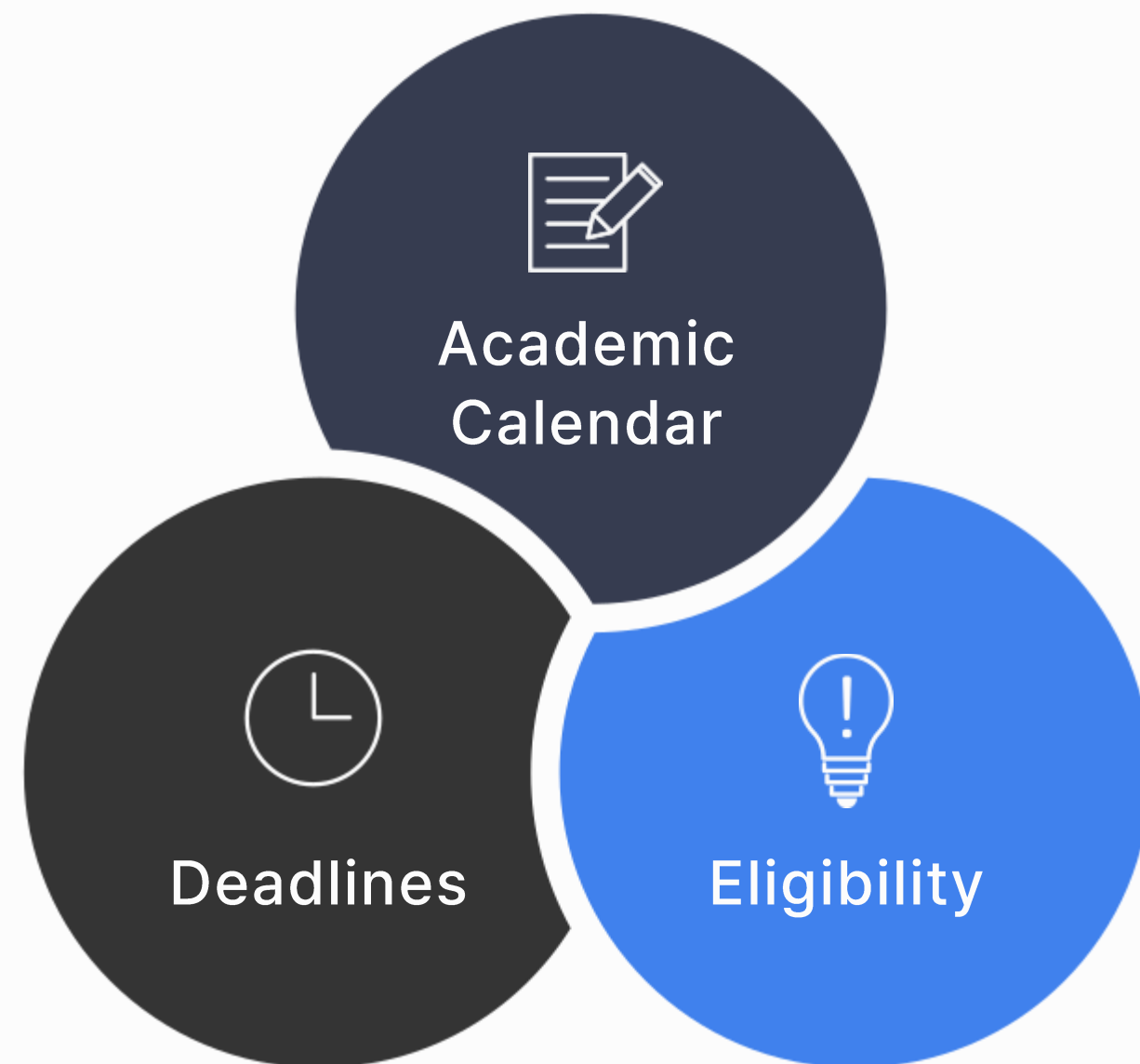

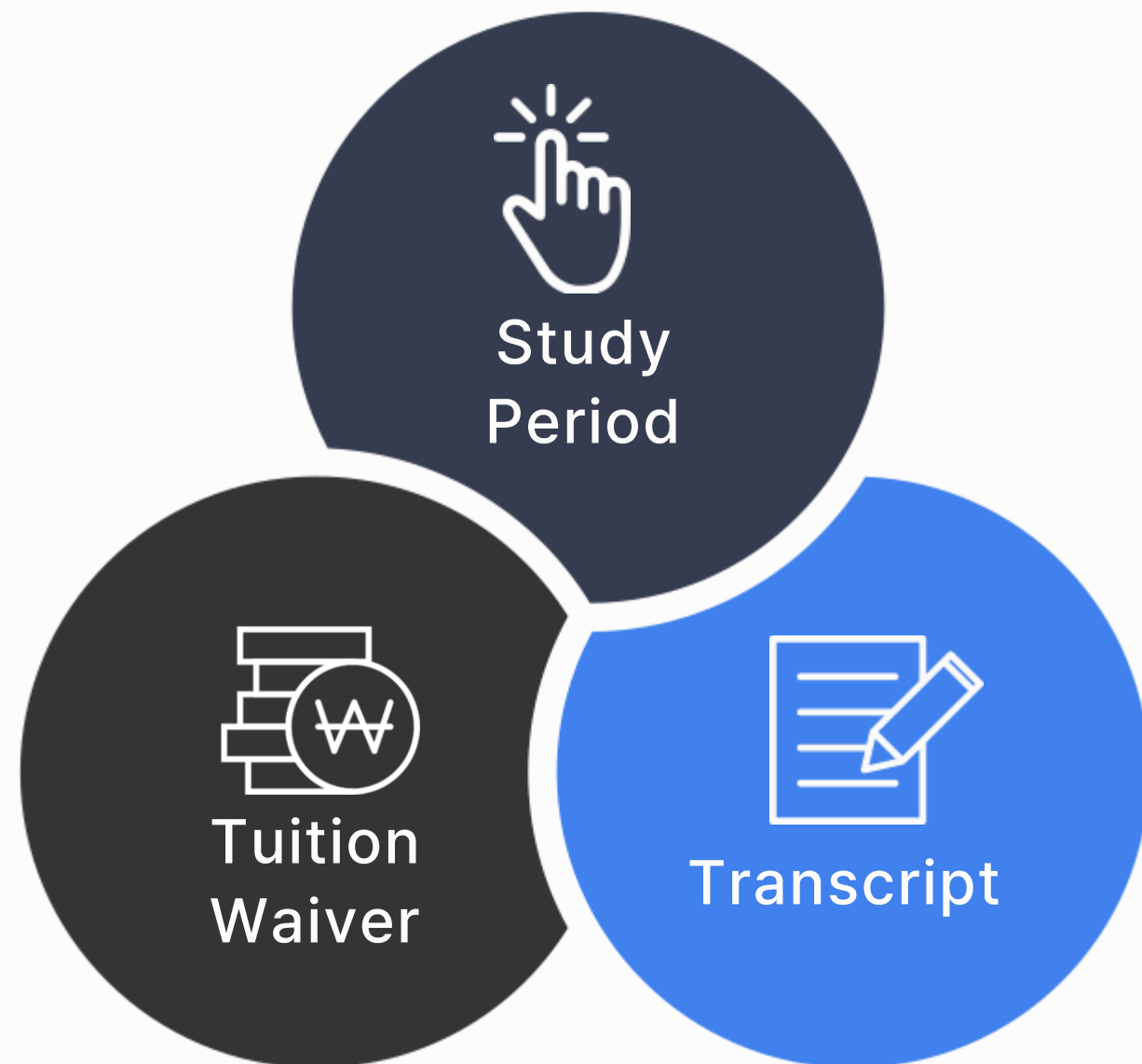

| Required Documents

Step 1

Step 1. Access the Online Application System[K-Cloud]

Applicants can access the application system [K-Cloud] only after they are nominated by their home university.

Step 2

Step 2. Online Apply

※ All documents should be prepared in English or Korean and uploaded via K-Cloud

1) Certificate of enrollment * Must be certified by APOSTILLE or the embassy in your country

2) University transcript

3) Recommendation letter from home university(professor or department)

4) Copy of Passport

5) Bank Statement Certificate (Proof of finance) **minimum balance: USD 4,500 for 1 semester/ USD 9,000 for 1 year*

6) Optional Korean or English Language Proficiency Certificates

Students from OECD countries may be exempt from the apostille on the certificate of enrollment and the submission of proof of finances, depending on visa requirements.

Please check with the Korean Embassy in your country to confirm whether the bank statement is required

Step 3

Step 3. Entry Survey [Spring] early February [Fall] early August

• Flight e-ticket, Medical check-list with the TB(chest x-ray) test result, dormitory application, etc.

• OIA will require to upload the documents to the KNU online system[K-Cloud] after a student receives an admission letter from KNU

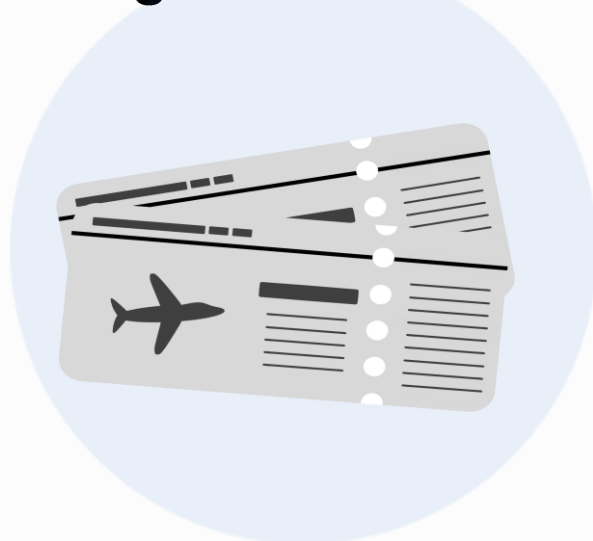

Please refer to the KNU Academic Calendar until the official dormitory moving-in/out dates are announced.

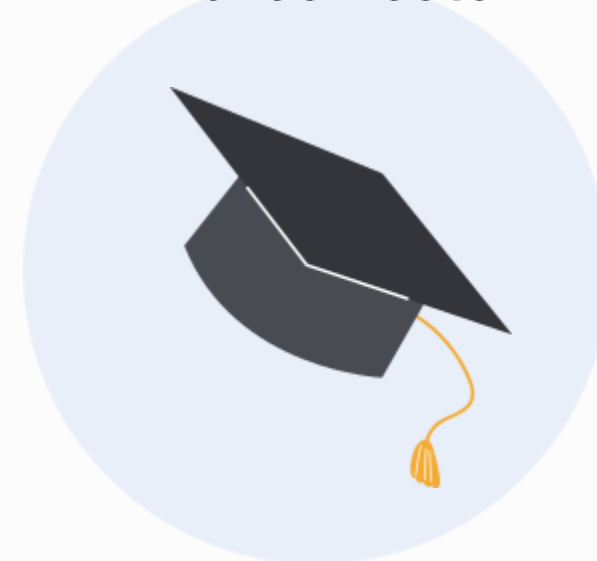
Non-credit Korean language course
